# NEW NORTH EDUCATION INITIATIVE 2018

## Increasing Opportunities

**The New North Education Initiative (NNEI) is a collaborative partnership between Dianella Secondary College, Balga, Eastern Hills, Girrawheen and Morley Senior High Schools within the North Metropolitan Education Region. This unique partnership provides enhanced opportunities for students, and the best of educational delivery for young adult learning. This alliance enables students at these schools to access a wider breadth of Senior School curriculum choices with specialist teachers, while remaining attached to their home school campus and is in response to community demands for excellence in education.**

## NNEI - Purpose

- Enhanced curriculum breadth
- Comprehensive academic stream offerings
- Promotion of excellence in local schools
- Development of successful programs in local schools
- State of the art Vocational Education and Training options
- Access to three Trade Training Centres
- Quality professional development for teaching staff

The shared, cooperative curriculum delivery across five sites has attracted considerable local and state wide interest. Student achievement has improved through this alliance by enabling students at NNEI schools access to Senior Secondary Schooling curriculum choices beyond the limits of what is offered at their home school. Currently 100 students travel between schools to access courses of their choice.

## What can you expect

The schools in the initiative deliver a range of courses across five campuses. The shared courses are offered in two blocks of two hours per week throughout the school year or as whole day courses in the specialist Trade Training Centres.

Students accessing the shared courses at NNEI schools are required to make their own travel arrangements at the start and end of the school day (to or from the host school). Travel between the host schools and home schools during the school day will be provided by the NNEI Bus. In the case of Eastern Hills Senior High School, travel arrangements are different because of the more distant location and nature of the delivery of the shared course offerings.



Students are invited to access a placement in a shared course at an NNEI school if their home school is unable to offer the course, or the student's choices do not fit the courses offered on their home school's timetable.



# TRADE TRAINING CENTRES

The New North Education Initiative is leading the way in providing prevocational programs in Automotive, Building & Construction and Hospitality, to ensure students are knowledgeable and industry ready prior to seeking apprenticeships and pathways towards further training.

## **Building and Construction Trade Training Centre at Girrawheen SHS**

### **Certificate II in Building & Construction (Pathway-Trades)**

### **Bricklaying/Blocklaying and Tiling Electives**

The Girrawheen SHS Certificate II in Building and Construction (Pathway-Trades) is a two year two day a week program available to students in Year 11 who are interested in pursuing a career in the Building and Construction Industry. The course is nationally recognised, delivered by North Metropolitan TAFE and enables students to gain direct experience and skills in many facets of the building and construction industry while still working towards their secondary graduation. The program is suitable for students who:

- have a passion and a commitment to the building and construction industry
- would like a quicker and more meaningful transition into either work or training
- enjoy hands on learning and wish to enhance their life skills.

The Certificate II in Building and Construction (Pathway-Trades) is the industry's preferred pathway for students seeking entry into an apprenticeship or traineeship in industry. Completion of the course will give students the opportunity of making a successful transition from school to full time employment or further training. Workplace Learning is a compulsory component of the qualification.

Upon completion of the Certificate II in Brick/Blocklaying, students will have the opportunity to enroll in Tiling Electives. The Tiling Electives will be credited as additional units of competence and expose students to a broader range of careers within the construction industry. With additional work placement outside the Trade Centre hours students will have the ability to complete dual certificates.





## The Hospitality Training Centre at Dianella Secondary College

### Certificate II in Hospitality (Kitchen Operations)

The Dianella Secondary College Hospitality Training Centre offers students in Year 11 who are interested in the Hospitality Industry or Business and Events Management an opportunity to gain direct entry into the world of work or training while still working towards their secondary graduation. The program is suitable for students who have a passion for hospitality and events management and would like to pursue an industry pathway and/or tertiary studies.

The pathway links include:

- Hospitality Industry Apprenticeship and/or
- Bachelor of Business and Events Management.

## Automotive Pre-apprenticeships at Morley SHS

### Certificate II in Automotive Servicing Technology

The Morley SHS Automotive Pre-Apprenticeship is a flexible learning program available to students in Year 11 who want to gain direct entry into the world of work or training while still working towards their secondary graduation. The program is suitable for students who:

- have a passion and a commitment to the automotive industry
- would like a quicker and more meaningful transition into either work or training

A Certificate II in Automotive Servicing Technology will give students the opportunity of making a successful transition into full time automotive apprenticeships, other traineeships, further TAFE training or full time employment. All students who successfully complete this national qualification will have their indentured period of an automotive apprenticeship reduced by six months.
